Learning outcomes of Course unit - Students will develop understanding of specific strategies in teaching Art, as well as other preschool subjects, using puppetry and dramatics. - Students will discover a variety of Puppetry and Theater resources. - Students will be capable for directing and producing puppet show as a teaching instrument and method.			
Course unit contents <i>Theoretical classes</i> - This course will consist of informal lectures, demonstrations, studio assignments and critique. Topics include history of puppetry, types of puppets, crafting puppet, puppet “voice”, props and set design, and directing. <i>Practical classes</i> - Group research project. Various types of puppets. - Individual research project. Puppet presentation and puppet show. - Design and present standard based lesson using puppetry.
