2. Detailed requirements and additional information

2.1. Recommended language skills

The sending institution home is responsible for providing support to its nominated candidates so that they can have the recommended language skills at the start of their study at the minimum level as stated in Erasmus+ bilateral agreement.

We require incoming students to have at least **B2 level** of language proficiency (in the chosen language of instruction) based on the CEFR. Therefore we ask students to send a document testifying their level of language competence of the chosen language of instruction (not relevant for students from Czech Republic).

2.2. Application procedure for students

All incoming students must be nominated by their sending institution via e-mail yet till the nomination deadline (see table below).

Nominated student fills in the following forms:

- Application Form for Exchange Programme
- Learning Agreement for Studies (or Learning Agreement for Traineeship)
- Transcript of Records (list of courses passed at home institution so far)
- Document testifying minimum B1 level of language competence (not required from Czech students)
- Housing Application for Incoming Students (for living in a student dormitory)
- Slovak Language Course Application Form (in case of interest).

Free of charge Slovak Language Course

Each semester we offer free of charge Slovak Language Course for incoming students (course name: Slovak for Foreigners, course code: JC/SKFOR/15, 2 ECTS, <https://www.ukf.sk/en/erasmus/ects-course-catalogues>). The course is provided by the Language Center of the Faculty of Arts, Constantine the Philosopher University in Nitra. Language of instruction is English, course takes 2 teaching hours/week and is held during the whole semester. For attending the course, don't forget to send us the filled Slovak Language Course Application Form.

2.5. Grading system

Constantine the Philosopher University in Nitra applies ECTS and its grading system is as follows:

- Excellent = 1 (A)*
- Very good = 1,5 (B)
- Good = 2 (C)
- Satisfactory = 2,5 (D)
- Sufficient = 3 (E)
- Unsatisfactory / Unsufficient/Failed = 4 (FX or F)

2.12. Living costs

Approximate prices of the living costs and set-up costs in Nitra are:

- Accommodation in UKF dormitories: 37 - 92 € per month
- Rent of 1, 2 or 3 bedroom flat: from 300 - 700 € per month
- Meal in the UKF canteens: approx. 2,5 €
- Restaurant meal: from 4 - 7 €
- Medical examination (non-EU students): approx. 150 €
- Commercial health insurance (non-EU students): approx. 300 € per year
- Administration fee for the residence card: 4,5 €
- Local transport, basic single ticket: from 0,30 – 0,80 €
- Taxi within Nitra: approx. 2 € per 1 travel within Nitra town
