#### Brief Description of Institution

The University of Kragujevac is a higher education institution, embracing almost all major areas of teaching and research and offering a wide range of accredited study programs at Bachelor, Master and PhD levels at 12 faculties in Kragujevac, Kraljevo, Jagodina, Cacak, Uzice, and Vrnjacka Banja. The University comprises the following centres: the University Centre for Career Development and Student Counselling; University Information Centre; Joint Centre for Scientific Research of Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts, and the University of Kragujevac. Furthermore, the University of Kragujevac has founded the Institute for Information Technologies, and also has the University Library. The University of Kragujevac offers a joint Bachelor program Psychology, and four Master programs, conducted by the Rectorate of the University of Kragujevac. Finally, the University of Kragujevac offers an international joint Master program called Erasmus Mundus Master in Biomedical Engineering – EMMBIOME
