## **The Framework Cooperation Agreement**

**between**

**University of Kragujevac (Kragujevac, Serbia)  
represented by Rector Professor Vladimir Ranković**

**and**

**Krakow University of Economics (Krakow, Poland)  
represented by Rector Professor Bernard Ziębicki**

### **§ 1**

1. University of Kragujevac and Krakow University of Economics are willing to cooperate within the following areas:

- 1.1 student exchange,
- 1.2 faculty and staff exchange,
- 1.3 exchange of scientific and didactic materials, experiences and ideas
- 1.4 joint research and educational activities,
- 1.5 cooperation within the framework of European Union and other institutions programmes.

2. Both Universities are committed to fostering joint projects in the field of education and research and are open to any form of the potential cooperation.

### **§ 2**

The mutual exchange, specified in §1, shall be kept in equilibrium for the period of 2 years.

### **§ 3**

The Home University or a visiting person shall cover all travel expenses to the Host University as well as the costs of internationally recognised health and accident insurance of the visiting persons. It is a responsibility of visiting person to purchase internationally recognised health and accident insurance valid during her/his stay in Host University.

### **§ 4**

This Agreement does not establish financial commitments between the institutions beyond what it stated in the article above.

### **§ 5**

Each form of cooperation shall be based on a Working Programme, which will specify its range and forms as well as details concerning the financing with reference to § 3 of this agreement.

**§ 6**

Each Working Programme must be signed by the persons responsible for its realisation (Rector, Vice-Rector, Dean, Head of Department etc.) and it must be approved by the university authorities.

**§ 7**

The following offices are responsible for coordination of all activities related to this agreement implementation:

- on behalf of University of Kragujevac:  
    Department of International Relations;
- on behalf of Krakow University of Economics:  
    International Relations Office.

**§ 8**

In performance of this agreement, both institutions will collect, disclose, use, maintain, and otherwise process academic records, student records, and all personal information in accordance with all applicable law, accreditation standards and policies. Both institutions will implement and maintain appropriate administrative, physical, and technical safeguards to protect the privacy, security and confidentiality of any data. Each party is a separate administrator of the personal data of students and employees qualified for exchange. Each party will fulfill legal obligations, including obtaining the necessary consents to transfer personal data to the other party in order to perform this agreement.

**§ 9**

The agreement becomes in force in the day of signing by legal representatives of both Universities and will be valid for 5 years.

**§ 10**

The agreement is terminable by both parties with 2 months written notice.

**§ 11**

This Agreement is executed in two originals in the English language, one for each University.
